

Dear New Salem Family,

I write this month for the purpose of introducing you to some of the recent happenings within our United Methodist Church.

I realize that some are aware, while others may not, that our UMC has been having discussions since late 2019 concerning the possibility of a "Split" within the denomination. The short version of this long story is that a proposal was set to be considered at our 2020 worldwide General Conference to divide the UMC into at least two and possibly three denominations. Because of the COVID Pandemic, that General Conference has been delayed three times now, and will not happen until sometime in 2024. The thing is though, none of the work around that proposal to split can take place until we hold a General Conference.

Because of the constant delays of the Conference, a worldwide group of UMC clergy and laity, who had developed a plan for a new theologically traditional denomination called "The Global Methodist Church", has decided to launch the start of that denomination on May 1, 2022. By now you might be asking yourself, "What does that mean for New Salem", and the answer in the immediate term is "Nothing". We are presently a United Methodist Church, and we will continue to honor our commitments to God and worship Him as a United Methodist Church.

What this does mean for you, the members of New Salem United Methodist Church, is that you need to begin the work of educating yourselves. It would be good for you to know what it will mean to either remain a part of the UMC denomination or to go in another direction. The explanations for these options are too extensive to handle within this one newsletter. Therefore, the New Salem Administrative Council is putting together a leadership team that will help guide New Salem UMC through all discussions, and eventual decisions, concerning these matters. Be looking for future information to come your way from your Administrative Council within the next couple of months.

I realize this can be a very anxious time within the church. What I am challenging you to do is to be in constant prayer for God to quell your anxiousness and those of other church members. I also ask for you to pray with me that God will guide and lead us through this time, and that New Salem will follow His will, and His alone. Please know that my door is always open to you anytime you wish to ask questions or discuss these, or any other matters of your concern.
