There is a Season

"For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven"

Ecclesiastes 3:1

The author of Ecclesiastes follows this statement with twenty-eight items that are, for the most part, contrasts — to be born and to die, to break down and build up... These words reflect the fact that God determines life events for each of us, ones that, at times, are hard to understand. Lent is a season that we can, as individuals and a church, reflect on our relationship with God, God's creation, and others.



All to often, we want to go directly to the empty tomb and the colorful spring flowers and joyful feelings of Easter morning. Yet, Ecclesiastes shows us the importance of contrasting seasons. It is only through the respect (re-spect), or "re-seeing" of the hard times that we are able to understand the easier ones. It is only through the passion of Christ that we are able to understand and appreciate the resurrection and salvation.

I hope and pray that we take the opportunity this Lent season to reflect on those relationships in our lives and church that need restoration. I pray that we have the courage to allow the Holy Spirit to guide and navigate us, to "re-see" those places that need rest, healing, and forgiveness. By respecting the season of Lent, we can then appreciate the gift of Easter morning.
